### **SAME MASS+++++NEW WORDS+++++SAME MASS+++++NEW WORDS**



**On the First Sunday of Advent, November 26/27, the words we use in the Mass will change.**

For the next few weeks we are going to look at the meaning behind some of these changes.

One of the most noticeable changes in the Mass parts is the people's response to the priest's greeting, "The Lord be with you." Currently we respond "And also with you."

In the new translation we will reply, **"AND WITH YOUR SPIRIT."**

This is a closer translation of the Latin *Et cum spiritu tuo* and it matches the response that already exists in most other major languages.

The purpose of this greeting is not just to say, *Hello or Good morning.* It tells everyone present that they are entering a sacramental realm and reminds them of their responsibilities during this time we spend at prayer.

Both the greeting and the reply come from the Bible and express a desire that the Lord be present to the spirit of the entire community. This dialogue also establishes the interdependence of the priest and the people as they take up their roles to praise God.
